Position Summary: The Summer Museum Education Assistant assists with the planning and delivery of Summer Camp for children ages 5-11 on a variety of natural history themes and takes the lead on delivery of one K-grade 2 camp and one grade 3-5 camp.

The Museum Education Team is a group of creative and collaborative scientist-educators. We look forward to including an energetic educator with a strong sense of fun to the team for the summer.

Education and Experience:

High school graduation desirable. Work or volunteer experience working with elementary-age children required.

Working Conditions:

Essential and marginal functions may require maintaining physical condition necessary for standing or sitting for extended periods; walking up to 1 mile; moderate lifting such as setting up tables and chairs. The position requires the need to lift exhibit items weighing up to 40 pounds. This position will involve working both indoors and outdoors in a variety of weather conditions.

First aid and CPR certification is required. This may be obtained after hire. And a background check is required of all education staff.
